Why collect pull tabs?

Pull tabs are an easy way to help the environment and help families at Ronald McDonald House Charities ® Newfoundland and Labrador at the same time. Anyone in your family, school, business, church, or service club can join in. these small pull tabs are a clean source of aluminum that are easy to store. Collecting pull tabs will not interfere with an existing Recycling Program.

Which pull tabs?

We will be happy to accept donations of aluminum tabs from beverage cans, fish and meat tins, soups, and cat and dog food tins. All you have to do is **pull 'em and save 'em!**

Do you also recycle beverage containers?

Where are Pull Tabs and Beverage Containers Recycled?

We have a number of recycling locations available to help us with our fundraising efforts with accounts for RMHC already set up. When delivered, pull tabs are weighed and beverage containers are counted and redeemed for cash. St. John's: (PULL TABS ONLY) Drop off your pull tabs at RMHC at 150 Clinch Crescent in St. John's, anytime during the hours of 9am and 9pm, seven days a week. They can easily be deposited in our Pull Tab Collection House in the main lobby.



Where does the money go?

The dollars raised from recycling pull tabs go directly to providing the programs and services for families at Ronald McDonald House Charities ® Newfoundland and Labrador.

Taking care of the earth by recycling is just the tip of the iceberg. By donating your pull tabs to RMHC, you're helping to provide a "home away from home" for sick children and their families during what could be the most difficult time of their lives.

Quick Facts:

- It takes 1400 pull tabs to make 1 lb
- In 2015, 2000 lbs of pull tabs were donated to Ronald McDonald House and recycled - that's 2.8 million pull tabs
- In 2015, pull tabs have covered the cost for 1 tamily to stay at Ronald McDonald House for 15 nights
- Since opening in 2012, 3600 lbs of pull tabs were donated and recycled
 that's more than 5 million pull
