can't fight cancer alone

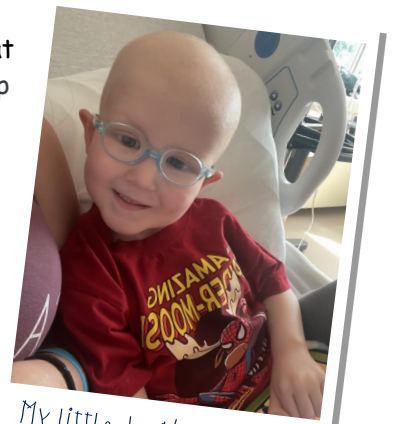

I promised to love my new little brother, Ryder, and teach him all the important stuff in life; like playing games, making friends, and what toys were his and which ones were mine. **But most of all, I promised to always be there for him.**

Last year I started kindergarten and we got a new puppy. It was awesome. I was learning new things and making lots of new friends. I was becoming a big kid! But then, just after the holidays, Ryder wasn't feeling well. Mom said he had a cold that just wouldn't go away.
