Operated by a small staff and supported by dedicated volunteers, we now seek the services of a **casual Family Services Associate** that would be scheduled a minimum of 20 hours per week during a combination of **overnights, evenings, and weekends. The ability to work weekday overnights is required.** This position will have the possibility for additional hours going forward.

Reporting to the Family and Volunteer Services Manager, the Family Services Associates' key responsibilities include:

- Smooth operation of the House during a combination of overnights, evenings, and weekends.
- Greeting guests when they arrive
- Managing the admission process
- Providing assistance and information to guests
- Controlling access to the House
- Administrative duties such as report preparation
- Providing direction for volunteers in the House
- Managing data in computerized reservation system
- Be able to lift a minimum of 25 pounds. Be able to complete housekeeping physical requirements, such as mopping, laundry, general cleaning

Qualifications: These positions are unique - a career with real meaning and sense of purpose, which offers the satisfaction of 'making a difference' in the community. The ideal candidate will have experience in the not-for-profit sector, residential care, and/or hospitality industry. Minimum requirements include:
