Family is medicine, and for the past 13 years, it has been helping 16-Year-old Aaron Cooper, of Lewisporte, NL, have his family with him at Ronald McDonald House.

It is hard to put into words how a parent feels when their child has been diagnosed with multiple medical concerns. It must be one of the most difficult experiences for a family, and for families who don't live close to the medical care and resources they need, there is the added stress of distance. Ronald McDonald House gives families with a sick or injured child what they need most – each other.

In 2009, Patsy and Dave Cooper welcomed triplets, Aaron, Allie, and Aiden to their lives. The trio were born very premature at 27 weeks. Sadly, baby Aiden passed away after just nine days. Prior to their arrival, the Coopers were aware that Aaron had down syndrome, and they were prepared to have the Janeway Children's Hospital be a continuous part of their lives. But they weren't prepared for the increased health risks that followed. When Aaron was just over a year ago, he had to be airlifted to St. John's where he was diagnosed with diabetes. This secondary health concern meant even more visits to St. John's, almost 400km away from home. Staying at Ronald McDonald House has brough the family comfort.

"When you are getting up and not sure what the day will hold for you and your child, walking into the kitchen in the morning to find a spread of breakfast items all laid out for you to choose from is a refreshing start to the day." said Aaron's dad, Dave.

When Aaron was 12 years old, it was discovered that he had a leg length discrepancy. There was 1.5 centimeters of play where the ball went into the socket of his left hip. To repair this discrepancy, Aaron had to have surgery on his 14th birthday where they had to break his leg where the ball attaches to the leg bone and then reposition it. Aaron was back and forth to St. John's for many visits for rehabilitation and physiotherapy. Unfortunately, just over a year after the surgery, it was discovered that one of the pins had cracked off, and two additional pins had slacked off, meaning Aaron had to repeat the surgery again in November 2024.

"If Ronald McDonald House wasn't available, we would have had to stay in a motel for this duration, given that Aaron was in a wheelchair for most of this stay, this would have been quite the challenge. The room at Ronald McDonald House is awesome, very spacious and easy to get around using a wheelchair."

Having stayed at the Ronald McDonald House over 20 times, the family has come to rely on the programs and services and have developed a community of support. Dave says, "All the wonderful people we have met on our journeys, other families who we have connected with and still keep in touch with as we each continue on our separate medical journeys." While Aaron is doing well, his journey is far from over. The family anticipates staying at the Ronald McDonald House for many more years to come.


